MATTHEW ROSS, JUDICIAL COUNCIL PRESIDENT**AN ORDER PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
CONSTITUTION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY  
CONCERNING PETITIONING DURING ELECTIONS***Resolved by the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame du Lac,*

That the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body, pursuant to Section (I)(5) of the same, is hereby amended as follows:

**I. A new clause is hereby inserted between (XVII)(1)(d) and (XVII)(1)(e) and shall read as follows:**

(e) Petitioning may be held only over a period specified by the Election Committee. Petitioning consists of any public contact for the solicitation of signatures to get on a ballot. Any petitioning before or after the specified period is a violation of election rules, the penalty for which may include a maximum penalty of forfeiture of candidacy. Petitioning within LaFortune is allowed only in the basement and the 1st floor. No petitioning may take place in or near any Student Union office or venues occupied by the Student Union, including (but not limited to) all meetings, events, or agendas of official business, as well as space that is funded by the Student Activities Office.

(1) No potential candidates or their supporters may petition in any venue while occupied by a class period, exam, or during the passing period directly before and after classes.
