

Standing Committees Amendment

Drafted 4 April 1998

Whereas the current Undergraduate Body Constitution currently requires Senators to serve on two committees, but places no limit on the number of committees which a Senator may serve.

Whereas this leaves open the possibility for a Senator to serve on a committee just for the amount of time necessary to accomplish a personal goal and then remove him/herself from the committee.

Whereas such actions as mentioned may seriously undermine the integrity of the committee system.

Therefore be it resolved the Constitution of the Undergraduate Body be amended as follows:

Change Article III, Section V, part 5 to read:

Each Senator shall serve on at least two standing committees of the Senate, but may serve on no more than three standing committees.
