

Robert's Rules of Order Resolution

Drafted 5 April 1998

**Whereas** the Senate adheres to Robert's Rules of Order as the official rules of procedure governing the operation of the Senate.

**Whereas** parliamentary procedure can often be used to either help in passage or the death of a measure.

**Whereas** Senators currently only receive particular portions of these rules of procedure governing the operation of the Senate.

**Therefore** be it resolved that copies of Robert's Rules of Order are purchased for each member of the Senate's personal review for the time of one year. At the beginning of the term the Secretary of the Senate will issue one copy to each Senator. After the end of a Senator's term, the Senator must return his/her copy of the work to the Secretary of the Senate. The Secretary of the Senate will then issue the copies to the new incoming Senators. Replacement of copies of Robert's Rules of Order that are lost or damaged beyond use (as deemed by the Secretary of the Senate) is the personal financial responsibility of the Senator who was issued the work.
