

Resolution on Increasing the Number of Bike Racks on Campus

Drafted on 06 October 1998

WHEREAS, the 1998-99 school year has seen an increase in the number of bikes on campus;

WHEREAS, due to this increase, campus lacks a sufficient number of spaces for students to lock their bikes;

WHEREAS, students are forced to compromise the security of their bikes by leaving them unattached to a bike rack;

WHEREAS, the extra bikes are frequently left on the sidewalks, which presents a hazard to pedestrians and also detracts from the beauty of the campus;

WHEREAS, many buildings on campus currently lack sufficient spaces for the students' bikes. These buildings include: DeBartolo Hall, North and South Dining Hall, LaFortune Student Center, Alumni Hall, Breen-Philips Hall, Cavanaugh Hall, Dillon Hall, Farley Hall, Keough Hall, and McGlenn Hall. <sup>North side</sup> Spin, Stanford, Zeln, Lewis, Siegfried

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Student Senate asks Facilities Operations to provide the necessary number of bike racks in order to remedy this situation.
