

The amendment:

Change the Percentage of the CCC allocation to 36.75% in the by-law.

Rider: If the overall amended Bylaw amendment fails, it then returns to the floor at the current percentages set in the CCC proposal

Logic: This is a figure endorsed by the Hall Presidents Council and other members of the Executive Cabinet. If the CCC is willing to agree to this amount then a compromise satisfying almost everyone is reached. What this percentage really means: nothing. The CCC was awarded approximately 215,000 by the FMB last year. The FMB rarely allocates less than they have given the previous year. The CCC is virtually guaranteed to earn more than this in the Spring FMB allocations regardless if we pass this amended by-law amendment. CCC is given the ability to appeal to the Senate if they still feel need when the out-going Senate passes the budget in the spring. We trust the out-going Senate to honestly determine whether or not an appeal is just. If there is a just need the Senate will grant it to the CCC. Thus, they get enough money, but not too much. The scheduling is solved. And almost everyone walks away content if not happy.
