**A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
CONSTITUTION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY  
REGARDING SOCIAL MEDIA REGULATIONS IN CAMPAIGNS**

*Resolved by the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame du Lac,*

That the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body, pursuant to Section (1)(4) of the same, is hereby amended as follows:


**I. Subclause (f)(2) of Section 17.1 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

(f)(2) Candidates may create a social media account or page specifically for campaigning. The account or page must be approved by the Election committee before use and be made accessible to Judicial Council. All activity on a social media account or page, including but not limited to text posts, photos, and videos must adhere to the ethical guidelines detailed in 17.1(i).

**II. Subclause (f)(3) of 17.1 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

(f)(3) A personal social media account or page may be used to campaign. If the candidate uses their personal media account or page for their campaign, that personal media account or page must be made accessible to Judicial Council. All actions on a personal account or page (including but not limited to the posting of text posts, photos, and videos) which may be construed as campaigning must adhere to the ethical guidelines detailed in 17.1(i).
