**A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
CONSTITUTION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY  
CONCERNING THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY STANDARDS**

*Resolved by the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame du Lac,*

That the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body, pursuant to Sections (I)(4) of the same, is hereby amended as follows:

**I. Subsection (I)(3)(a), shall read as follows:**

- (a) Any undergraduate student enrolled at the University of Notre Dame who is of good academic standing, as determined by the Office of the Registrar or the First Year of Studies Program, and of good disciplinary standing, as determined by the Office of Community Standards, shall be eligible to hold an office in the Notre Dame Student Union.

**II. Subsection (XVII)(1)(a), shall read as follows:**

- (a) Any Notre Dame undergraduate student in good academic standing (as determined by the Office of the Registrar or the First Year of Studies) and good disciplinary standing (as determined by the Office of Community Standards) is eligible for candidacy.

**III. Subsection (XVII)(2)(i)(1), shall read as follows:**

- (a) Candidates must furnish independent proof of good academic standing from the First Year of Studies or the Office of the Registrar and proof of good disciplinary standing from the Office of Community Standards.
