**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ORGANIZATIONAL BYLAWS OF THE

Whereas, on 2 September 2013, Alexander Coccia, Student Body President of the University of Notre Dame, attended the inaugural ACC Student Body President Conference hosted by the University of Pittsburgh and Florida State University;

Whereas, the aim of the ACC Student Body President Conference is to foster cross-campus communication between active institutions in the ACC; continue the pursuit of being pioneers of higher education, athletics, and extracurricular activities; enable collective actions that affect all participating institutions; and promote a strong relationship among all institutions;
