**A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY
MAKING REVISIONS FOR THE PURPOSES OF
CONSISTENCY AND CLARITY**

I. Article IV is hereby amended to read as follows:**ARTICLE IV****EXECUTIVE POLICY BOARD****Section 4.1. Composition.**

- (a) The following members shall attend the weekly Executive Policy Board meeting:
- (1) Chief of Staff.
 - (2) Standing and ad hoc Senate Committee Chairs.
 - (3) Executive Controller.
 - (4) Student Union Webmaster.
 - (5) Academic Delegate.
 - (6) Student Union Secretary.
 - (7) Student Body President.
 - (8) FUEL Directors.
 - (9) Parliamentarian.

- (b) The Student Body Vice-President shall chair these meetings.

Section 4.2. Purpose & Duties.

- (b) The Executive Policy Board shall advance the agenda of the Student Body President and Vice-President through the Senate in an effort to protect the interests of students in all areas of university life, provide services to the undergraduate student body, and advance the policy priorities of the Student Union.

II. Article V is hereby amended to read as follows:**ARTICLE V****EXECUTIVE PROGRAMMING BOARD****Section 5.1. Composition.**

- (a) The following members shall attend the weekly Executive Programming Board meeting:
- (1) One Hall Presidents' Council Co-Chair.
 - (2) Four Class Vice-Presidents.

- (3) Club Coordination Council Vice-President.
- (4) Off-Campus Vice-President.
- (5) Student Union Board Director(s) of Programming.
- (6) Student Union Webmaster.

(b) The Chief of Staff shall chair the meeting.

(c) The Director of Student Activities shall appoint an advisor to the Executive Programming Board.

Section 5.2. Purpose & Duties.

(a) The Executive Programming Board shall facilitate the coordination, communication, and calendar setting of all Student Union groups whose primary responsibility is to serve the programming needs of the student body.

(b) The primary goal of this group will be to prevent overlap in programming and to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of each of the aforementioned groups' events in an effort to draw more students to each group's events. This shall be done by setting and updating a calendar with all planned and proposed events for each group.

(c) The Executive Programming Board shall meet every other week and shall discuss events that each organization is programming or plans to program. Any events that an organization has discussed internally that have the potential to conflict or be affected by other organizations' events shall be presented at this meeting regardless of the event's status.

(d) Members of the Executive Programming Board may invite members of any other student organizations to meetings of the Board with the intent of great facilitation of the programming calendar.

(e) Any events, planned or proposed, being added to an organization's calendar shall be presented to the Student Union Secretary and the Chief of Staff the day before each Executive Programming Board meeting.

(f) The Chief of Staff shall be responsible for setting the calendar at the Executive Programming Board meetings.

(g) During these meetings, the Executive Programming Board shall present the Student Union Webmaster with information regarding all programmed events that are going to happen.

III. Clause (I)(4)(b)(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) A two-thirds vote of all present and voting members of the Senate and the signature of the Student Body President.

IV. Subsection (VI)(2)(c) is hereby repealed.

V. A new subsection, to be designated Subsection (VI)(4)(d), shall be inserted after Subsection (VI)(4)(c) and shall read as follows:

(d) Any member of the Senate shall lead the body in a short prayer to begin a meeting.

VI. Subsection (VI)(2)(e) is hereby repealed.

VII. A new subsection, to be designated Subsection (VI)(4)(k), shall be inserted after Subsection (VI)(4)(j) and shall read as follows:

(k) Should an agenda item affecting the interests of the faculty come before the Student Senate, the Chairperson may recognize a representative of the Faculty Senate to address the Student Senate on the issue.

VIII. Clause (VI)(2)(i)(4) is hereby repealed.

IX. Subclause (VI)(7)(b)(1)(F) is hereby repealed.

X. Subsection (VI)(7)(l) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(l) All new Senators entering office in April shall attend a Celebrating Diversity Workshop as coordinated by the Senate Committee on Multicultural Affairs. This event is mandatory for all Senators and shall take place by October 1.

XI. Any section, subsection, clause, or subclause whose proper numbering is affected by this resolution shall be renumbered accordingly.

XII. This act shall take effect pursuant to Section 1.4 of the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body.
