BEN NOE, DIRECTOR**A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY
CONCERNING THE SELECTION OF HALL OF THE YEAR**

- I. A new subsection, to be designated Subsection (VIII)(3)(b), shall be inserted where appropriate and shall read as follows:**
- (b) Attendance at all meetings of the Hall Presidents' Council by at least one member of hall government is mandatory. Cases of excessive absenteeism shall be referred to the Student Union Ethics Commission at the discretion of the Hall Presidents' Council Co-Chairs.
- II. A new section, to be designated Section (VIII)(4), shall be inserted where appropriate and shall read as follows:**

Section 8.4. Hall of the Year.

- (a) The decision to award the title of Hall of the Year to a residence hall shall be decided by a review board comprised of the following members:
- (1) Both Hall Presidents' Council Co-Chairs.
 - (2) Both Hall Presidents' Council Treasurers.
 - (3) Both Hall Presidents' Council Social Chairs.
 - (4) The Hall Presidents' Council Athletics Chair.
 - (5) Two (2) Senators, who shall not sit on their own halls' review boards.
 - (6) One (1) member of the senior Judicial Council leadership.
- (b) The review board shall receive presentations from a maximum of three (3) members of hall government. The presence of the Hall President is required, and the review board will not hear any presentation in the absence of the Hall President.
- (c) Each member of the review board may allocate up to ten (10) points to each hall, for a total of 100 points available to each dorm. In addition to these points, each residence hall that wins a Rockne Award shall be awarded three (3) bonus points for each Rockne Award they win. After the total points for each hall are tabulated, the Hall Presidents' Council Co-Chairs shall announce the winning residence hall as Hall of the Year at the student leadership awards dinner. In the event of a tie, the Hall Presidents' Council Co-Chairs, Treasurers, Social Chairs, and Athletics Chair shall vote for a winner.

(d) All records of point allocation and voting in the event of a tie shall be made available to the public upon request once a winner has been announced.

III. This act shall take effect pursuant to Section (I)(4) of the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body.
