Whereas, Karen Suzanne Koski served faithfully and dutifully in the office of Chief Executive Assistant during the 2008-2009 term and made considerable efforts to advance the interests of the Student Body of the University of Notre Dame;

Whereas, Karen served as an organizer and manager to the Student Body President, Vice President, Student Senate, and Committee Chairs, at times receiving little public recognition for her hard work and enthusiasm while she made indispensable contributions to the success of many Student Government initiatives;

Whereas, Karen's willingness to complete any needed task at any given time allowed for an extremely effective term;

Whereas, Karen's hospitable accommodations for all visitors to the student government office allowed for the establishment of an increase in future relationships;

Whereas, Karen's detailed note-taking, capabilities of keeping track of every necessary approval, maintenance of the Student Government website, leadership on the Executive Programming Board, and high quality of organizational tactics served as integral factors to the success of the 2008-2009 term;

Whereas, Karen's specific work with the American Red Cross Blood Drive, FLEX Program, University of Portland visit, and the College Symposium led to significantly successful achievements by Student Government;

Whereas, by chairing the Task Force on Medical Amnesty Policy Review, Karen has laid the initial groundwork to further research in a topic important to students;
