**A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY
REVISING ARTICLE I, GENERAL PROVISIONS**

I. Paragraph (3) of Subsection (c) of Section 1.2. is hereby repealed.

II. Paragraph (3) of Subsection (c) of Section 1.2 shall now read as follows:

Section 1.2. Authority.

(a) This Constitution shall mandate the following —

(3) All members of the Senate and Council of Representatives must be given an

abridged copy of *Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised* as well as a copy of this Constitution.

III. In Subsection (c) of Section 1.2, all mention of an “Ethics Committee” shall be changed to “Ethics Commission.”

IV. Subsection (b) of Section 1.3 is hereby repealed.

V. Subsection (b) of Section 1.3 shall now read as follows:

Section 1.3. Eligibility for Office.

(b) Elected officials in all Student Union organizations listed in this Constitution

including appointed Senate Committee Chairs must be present for their entire term.

(1) No person intending on studying abroad during the desired term shall be eligible for an elected position.

VI. Paragraph (2) of Subsection (b) of Section 1.4 is hereby repealed.

VII. Paragraph (2) of Subsection (b) of Section 1.4 shall now read as follows:

Section 1.4. Amendment.

(b) A presented amendment to this Constitution shall be adopted with the following actions —

(2) If the Student Body President does not sign an amendment passed by a two-thirds vote of all voting members of the Senate, he

or she shall return it to the Senate at the next Senate meeting, stating his or her objections. The Senate shall then discuss the objections and may adopt the amendment with a five-sixths vote of all voting members of the Senate.

VIII. This act shall take effect pursuant to Section 1.4 of the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body.
