COMMITTEE FOR RECTOR APPLICANTS**

Whereas, Living alongside students in the residence hall and accompanying them on their journey of faith, the rector counsels and advises, provides critical support, and when necessary, calls students to accountability (ORLH website);

Whereas, Rectors are committed to the growth and development of college students. Each Rector is responsible for selecting and supervising six to eleven staff members and for developing and implementing religious, community-service, social, and educational programs that support the University's mission (Dulac 41);

Whereas, The student involvement within the interview process only includes a brief luncheon with the candidates; and

Whereas, Student Senate believes that the two students need to represent the student body and its goals and need to be selected in a transparent manner; therefore, be it

Resolved, Student Senate requests that The Office of Student Affairs allows the Student Body President to select two students to be involved in the process of selecting new Rectors;

Resolved, The two students selected by the Student Body President should have intimate knowledge of the residential life community in order to directly assist the Office of Student Affairs in the selection of a new rector throughout the interview process;

Resolved, That the two students are involved with the Office of Student Affairs in the final discussion of a rector candidate.
