

ARTICLE VI: SENATE

Section V: Committees

1. The Committee on Gender Issues shall address undergraduate student needs concerning issues of gender and the development of women's resources and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate.
2. The Committee on **Social Concerns shall address student needs as they relate to social concerns including, but not limited to, religious, sexual orientation, and socioeconomic issues and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate.** ~~Diversity Affairs shall address issues of multiculturalism and diversity and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate. In order to accomplish this goal, the Chair(s) of the Committee on Diversity Affairs must attend the monthly Diversity Council of Notre Dame (DCND) meetings. They must also have a meeting with the Director of Multicultural Student Programs and Services (MSPS) once monthly.~~
3. **The Committee on Multicultural Affairs shall address the needs and represent the concerns of racially and ethnically marginalized students, including international students, and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate.**
4. The Committee on Academic Affairs shall address undergraduate student needs as they relate to the academic affairs of the university and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate. The Academic Delegate shall serve as a non-voting member of the Academic Affairs Committee.
5. The Committee on University Affairs shall address concerns and issues pertinent to the mission of the University of Notre Dame. This Committee shall make appropriate recommendations to the Senate.
6. The Committee on Residence Life shall address undergraduate student needs in all areas of residence life and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate.
7. The Committee on Oversight shall monitor the transition, internal review, and overall process of the Student Union as outlined in this Constitution and make appropriate recommendations to the Senate.
8. The Committee on Community Relations shall address the relations between the student body and the residents of the Michiana area as it works to build a lasting relationship between the two groups. This committee will serve as a liason between students and the South Bend community while working to ensure that the Notre Dame student body plays an active role in community life.
