RESOLUTION TO URGE A REVIEW OF CAMPUS DOMER DOLLAR CARD SWIPE SYSTEMS

WHEREAS the Residence Life Committee has assessed the status of the Domer Dollar system across campus, predominantly within residence halls; and

WHEREAS students of the University of Notre Dame invest in Domer Dollars with reasonable expectations of their transactional value; and

WHEREAS the Residence Life Committee has deliberated and determined that the card swipe system frequently goes offline and prohibits students from using Domer Dollars; and

WHEREAS students rely on Domer Dollars to do chores such as laundry and purchase snacks, soft drinks, and other items through campus vending machines; and

WHEREAS it is unreasonable that students should not have access to a service for which they have already paid; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an administrative analysis be conducted of the Domer Dollar card swipe system that studies the frequency, location, timing and root causes of system outages; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Student Senate urges the Department of Food Services to work with all appropriate parties including the Office of Information Technologies and the Vending Software Company and dedicate adequate resources to enhance the reliability of the campus Domer Dollar card swipe systems.
