**Whereas** Fr. Malloy led the most successful capital campaign in Notre Dame history, entitled "Generations", setting out to raise \$767 million but collecting over \$1.1 billion for the University; and

**Whereas** Fr. Malloy oversaw the expansion of the University with the construction of Rolfs Athletic Facility, Reckers, Legends, and six new residence halls, as well as the magnificent DeBartolo Performing Arts Center, which demonstrates Fr. Malloy's commitment to the arts at Notre Dame; and

**Whereas** the Student Body of the University of Notre Dame owes a great deal to a man who has helped to mold a truly loving and truly Catholic community; therefore

**Be It Resolved** that the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame, on behalf of the Student Body, extends its appreciation, respect, and admiration to Fr. Edward "Monk" Malloy; and
