

Proposed Amendment to Student Union Constitution Non-Discrimination Clause

ARTICLE I: GENERAL PROVISIONS

(Article I introduces the Student Union Constitution and discusses matters that pertain to the entire Constitution, including Name, Authority, Eligibility for Office, Amendments, and General Positions)

Section VI: Non-Discrimination Clause

1. This Constitution recognizes the God-granted rights of every person to respect, friendship, justice, and a welcoming environment, regardless of color, gender, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation, social or economic class, and nationality. This Constitution forbids any acts of harmful and unjust discrimination within the Student Union.
 2. Allegations of discriminatory activity shall be brought before the Student Union Ethics Committee as misconduct, under Article XIII, Section VII, Line 1 of this Student Union Constitution

Appendix A

Article XIII, Section VII, Line 1 currently reads:

Section VII: Student Union Ethics Committee

1. The Ethics Committee shall conduct hearings according to the Student Union constitution, its bylaws, and guidelines adopted by the Senate and the other Student Union organizations, including, but not limited to Financial Management Board, SUB, Hall President's Council, Class Councils, Council of Representatives and Judicial Council, and shall make recommendations to the Senate or the appropriate University offices in the event of misuse of undergraduate student organization funds or misconduct of undergraduate student organizations and their members.
