Men's Basketball Ticketing Exchange

**Whereas** many of the students who have purchased season tickets for the 2004-05 Men's Basketball season do not attend every game, and many of the students who did not purchase season tickets would like the opportunity to attend some of the basketball games,

**Whereas** the Ticketing Office has recently allowed students to trade tickets among themselves, requiring only the individual game ticket and a Student I.D. for admission,

**Whereas** the residence halls provide the best environment to initiate a Men's Basketball Ticket Exchange Program due to their convenience for a majority of students,

**Whereas** students residing off-campus do not have the same access to a residence hall and require a different means of exchange

**Therefore** be it resolved that Student Senate suggest the following Ticket Share program to the Hall Governments and Off-Campus Government as a means to expedite the exchange of Men's Basketball Tickets

# Ticket Share: Men's Basketball Ticket Exchange

In order to facilitate the exchange of Men's Basketball Tickets within the Student Body, the Ticket Share Program works through the residence halls to provide a central location for residents to offer tickets that will not be used and find tickets that will be used. The residence halls have been deemed the best venue to implement the exchange due to their close proximity and convenience to a majority of students. Because the halls vary in terms of size and active student participation, a standard program of exchange will help to ensure that all students get a similar chance to find a ticket.

## Description

Each hall government shall select a central location in their respective halls (e.g. Main Lobby, outside the rector's door). At this spot, a large paper banner will be attached to the wall. The banner will be supplied for hall governments by Student Government. It will be divided into two columns, Give and Take, and thirteen rows, representing each home basketball game. The following disclaimer will be written on the top of the banner: Ticket Share is designed as a free ticket exchange program. The banner will appear in the format as shown below:

Students will be directed to write their name, room number, and phone number in the appropriate fields. The Ticket Share banner in one dorm will not be limited to the residents of that dorm, in order to give those students in smaller dorms the opportunity to exchange tickets in a larger dorm. Hall governments can publicize the Ticket Share opportunity through their stall notes or any other means each government deems beneficial.

## Off-Campus Program

Because students that reside off-campus will not have the convenience of a dorm-centralized system, additional efforts must be made to accommodate the exchange of tickets among them. The Off-Campus Website can provide the opportunities with a format similar to that shown above and allow off-campus students to post available tickets or desired tickets along with their personal information.
