

**Proposed Amendments to the Student Union Constitution**  
**Re: Amendments to the Constitution, and Senate Representation on Executive Cabinet**

**Whereas** it is the common goal of all Student Union leaders to focus on making more efficient, effective and fair decisions on behalf of the student body,

**Given** that last May's Board of Trustees report illustrated the inefficiencies of Student Government,

**Noting** concerns of the budgeting approval process that have occurred last school year that stemmed from last year's budgeting approval process,

**Recognizing** that the Executive Cabinet has the broadest representation of Student Union leaders,

**Therefore be it resolved**, that the power of approving the budget be given to Executive Cabinet *stricken*

**Therefore be it further resolved**, that <sup>4</sup>~~three~~ senators and the Vice President of the Student Body be appointed by the Student Body President to voting membership on the Executive Cabinet, as outlined in Article 3, Section 3 of the Student Union Constitution. Thus ensuring the representation of the Senate on the Executive Cabinet in the budget approval process and any other affairs of the Executive Cabinet

**Therefore be it further resolved**, in the light that Executive Cabinet will be the most representative body of Student Union leaders that the power of amending the constitution, as outlined in Article 1, Section 4 of the Student Union Constitution, be transferred to the Executive Cabinet
