

Resolution Concerning Excused Absences for Postgraduate Opportunities

WHEREAS, DuLac currently only excuses absences for personal illness, death in the immediate family, and duties performed for the University; and,

WHEREAS, the students of Notre Dame attend interviews that force them to miss class; and,

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the University to prepare their students for life beyond the University; and,

WHEREAS, interviews are crucial elements in obtaining postgraduate opportunities, such as graduate school, service, or employment; and,

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for the University to have its students to obtain these postgraduate opportunities;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that DuLac shall be amended to include such interviews as excused absences.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that seniors shall have three (3) excused absences in one academic year to attend such interviews.
