Assignment of Public Relations Responsibility to the  
Steering Committee.

Drafted 16 September 2001

Insert clause in Senate Bylaws, Section 3, #9.

It currently reads:

"Those Senators elected as chairpersons of the seven standing Senate committees shall also be members of the Steering Committee. The Vice-President shall serve as chairperson of this committee. The Steering Committee shall discuss the business of and set the goals of the Student Senate. Chairpersons of ad-hoc committees can be added to the Steering Committee per the Vice-President's discretion."

Change it to read:

"Those Senators elected as chairpersons of the seven standing Senate committees shall also be members of the Steering Committee. The Vice-President shall serve as chairperson of this committee. The Steering Committee shall discuss the business of and set the goals of the Student Senate. Chairpersons of ad-hoc committees can be added to the Steering Committee per the Vice-President's discretion. The Vice-President shall also designate one member of the Steering Committee to the position of Public Relations Liaison. The Liaison, upon confirmation by the entire Senate, shall be responsible for the communication of Senate objectives to the various Notre Dame media outlets."

Resolution Concerning Excused Absences for Job Interviews

Drafted September 17, 2001

WHEREAS, DuLac currently only excuses absences for personal illness, death in the immediate family, and duties performed for the University; and,

WHEREAS, the students of Notre Dame go on numerous job interviews that force them to miss class; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the University's best interest that its students gain employment; and,

WHEREAS, job interviews are crucial elements in obtaining employment upon graduation, an important concern of many Notre Dame students; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that DuLac shall be amended to include job interviews as excused absences, as long as students send a letter to the dean of their college for the absence to be approved.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that seniors shall have four (4) excused absences in one academic year to attend job interviews.
