Whereas it is Notre Dame tradition that each class has a separate and distinct signature event;


Whereas the sophomore class is currently without a signature event;

Therefore be it resolved that the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame du Lac hereby establish the Sophomore Class Signature Event Planning committee; and,


Be it further resolved that the purpose of this committee will be to provide an effective forum to develop, discuss and plan a new sophomore class signature event.
