RECTOR'S FUND PACKAGE

RECTOR'S FUND BY-LAW:

Add to Student Union Fiscal Policy By-laws Section III, a clause 5: "For the purposes of the Rector's Fund, \$35,000 from "The Shirt" Charity Fund will be allocated to the Vice-President for Student Affairs annually. In the event that the Charity Fund annual income is less than \$100,000, (35%) of the amount the Charity Fund income in a given year shall be allocated to the Vice-President for Student Affairs."

CONDITIONS FOR PASSAGE OF THIS BY-LAW:

This by-law is passed with the intention of funding the Rector's Fund in the Office for Student Affairs. As the administration of this account will be handled by the Office of Student Affairs, the account transfer may only take place after the Financial Management Board has approved a developed plan for the allocation procedure of these funds to the rectors of each hall. Issues of account administration must be addressed within this plan. Questions which need to be answered in this administrative plan include, but are certainly not limited to:

1. NCAA athlete eligibility for receiving funds.
2. Will the account be held in lump sum or a certain amount allocated to each Residence Hall. In the event that the allocation to the Residence Halls does occur, will this amount be based on size?
3. Are Off Campus students eligible through their former Rector?
4. What are guidelines and limits for fund allocation?
5. Can students directly apply to the fund through a neutral Rector, and if so, how?
6. Who will act as an oversight on account distribution and how?
7. The Student Union Treasurer reserves the right to occasionally review fund expenditures, question allocations, and make recommendations.
8. The Student Union reserves the right to cease funding for the Rector's Fund at any given time through a change in the fiscal policy by-laws of the Student Union Constitution.
9. Is the account limited only to Undergraduates?
10. Confidentiality of fund requests must be ensured.
