Resolution Regarding The Bookstore

WHEREAS the bookstore is an important part of student academic life.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame du Lac hereby establish the Bookstore Academic Subcommittee; and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purpose of this committee will be to provide an effective forum to develop and discuss ways in which the bookstore can better serve students.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership of this committee should be comprised of, but not limited to: two senators, one of whom must be a member of the Senate Academic Committee, a member of SUB, a member of Flipside, a representative of the Office of the President, a member of the Faculty Senate and members of the bookstore's managerial staff.
