Resolution Regarding A Statement on the Academic Freedom of Students

WHEREAS references to the academic freedom of students occur in the Faculty Handbook of the University of Notre Dame, but there is no discussion of the academic freedom appropriate to students in duLac;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Office of the Provost and the Academic Council prepare a clear statement on academic freedom and associated responsibilities setting forth the University's commitment to the academic freedom of its students for inclusion in duLac and that it be prepared with deliberate speed;
