**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY'S
EFFORTS IN IMPROVING OUTDOOR WASTE & RECYCLING RECEPTACLES**

Whereas, The undergraduate student body has expressed concerns about the number of outdoor waste and recycling receptacles on campus;

Whereas, The current outdoor recycling bins appear to only serve bottles and cans;

Whereas, The Office of Sustainability has begun a review of the outdoor waste receptacles on campus in order to make recycling more accessible;

Whereas, The Office of Sustainability has reviewed several designs of new waste receptacles from the Department of Art, Art History, & Design;

Whereas, The Office of Sustainability has sought out the support of leaders within the student body for their review; and

Whereas, The Office of Sustainability has continually sought out the input of student leaders in their process; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the undergraduate student body requests the Office of Sustainability and the University Architect work in a joint effort to improve outdoor waste receptacles; and

Resolved, That the undergraduate student body supports the Office of Sustainability's review of the waste receptacles and provide any support, feedback, and input that will give the review a unique student perspective.
