SUB-COMMITTEES**

Whereas, it is the role of the Department of Gender Issues within Student Government to address and work to improve the dynamics of healthy student relations on campus including, but not limited to discussion of gender discrimination, sexual violence, and LGBTQ discrimination;

Whereas, the Residence Life System at Notre Dame may propagate these issues;

Whereas, currently, there exists no current student entity within Student Government to discuss the gender issues propagated by the Residence Life System;

Whereas, all First Year Students experience a PE Wellness Program and must attend the program College HAS Issues designed to initiate student discussion of the above issues; and,

Whereas, both of these programs are severely lacking their individual abilities to initiate this substantive discussion; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That a committee be established as a subset of the Department of Gender Issues to examine and renovate the Programs of College H.A.S. Issues and Physical Education Wellness in order to work to provide a dynamic forum for such discussion amongst first year students; and

Resolved, That a committee be established as a subset of the Department of Gender Issues in order to address, discuss, and work to improve the gender issues associated with the current Residence Life System.
