Whereas, Hydration Stations significantly decrease the amount of water bottles used on campus by 100,000 bottles per unit per year;

Whereas, Hydration Stations have already been implemented in all residence halls and Main Building with great success; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the undergraduate student body recommends that the University of Notre Dame provide funding for Hydration Stations in DeBartolo Hall so all students can enjoy clean, fresh-tasting water and the University can continue fulfilling its sustainability goals.
