

## **Resolution SS0506-13**

### **Amendment to Student Union Constitution**

#### **Re: Presidential Veto Procedure**

*The proposed amendment modifies the clause in the Student Union Constitution regarding the procedure by which a constitutional amendment may be vetoed by the president and subsequently overridden by the Senate. The new wording requires the president to return the amendment to the Senate for reconsideration if he/she chooses not to sign it.*

## **ARTICLE I: GENERAL PROVISIONS**

### **Section IV: Amendments**

1. An amendment to this Constitution may be presented to the Senate by any Senator, member of the Council of Representatives, or through a petition.
2. A presented amendment to this Constitution shall be adopted with the following actions:
  - a. A two-thirds vote of all voting members of the Senate and the signature of the Student Body President.
  - b. If the Student Body President does not sign an amendment passed by a two-thirds vote of all voting members of the Senate, **he/she shall return it to the Senate, stating his/her objections**, within two weeks, **at which time** the amendment may be adopted with a five-sixths vote of all voting members of the Senate.
  - c. The approval of the Student Activities Office.
