Good afternoon Daniel,

Our office received the request to provide the percentage of students (undergraduate) that have at least two classes offered before 10 a.m. in a given week in the Spring 2024 term.

Given these parameters, that percentage is 73.4%.

A few things to consider:

- The data is based on classes that begin before 10 a.m. Some may have ending times after 10 a.m.
- This is based upon meetings of a class, not based upon a unique class. Therefore, a course that meets twice a week (Tuesday/Thursday or Monday/Wednesday) will automatically count as two occurrences, and the students are included in the percentage as meeting the criteria.
- Some programs have lock-step curricula and courses, so course offerings can only take place at certain times, which may be early morning hours.
- This data is looking at all undergraduate students for the Spring 2024 term.
- The largest population with two or more classes before 10 a.m. are first-year students who work with an advisor to set their schedule.
- When the count is increased to three classes within a week, the percentage drops to 46.6%.
- When the count is increased to five classes within a week, the percentage drops to 19.5%.
