AN ORDER TO ADD A PERIOD TO THE CONSTITUTION

Whereas, Article I Section 3(a) states that “Any undergraduate student enrolled at the University of Notre Dame who is of good academic standing, as determined by the Office of the Registrar, and of good disciplinary standing, as determined by the Office of Community Standards, shall be eligible to hold an office in the Notre Dame Student Union”;

Whereas, this clause was recently edited and passed to reflect the correct offices responsible in determining an individual’s ability to hold office in the Notre Dame Student Union;

Whereas, however, the author of this order did not include a period at the conclusion of the updated clause, meaning that this is not a complete sentence in the Constitution;

Whereas, for reasons of consistency and proper grammar in the Constitution, it is important that a period be added to the end of this clause; therefore be it

Ordered by the Student Senate of the University of Notre Dame du Lac,

That the following be inserted at the end of the phrase in Article I Section 3(a) of the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Body:
